Subject: Minutes of the meeting held on 19.08.2015 at 11.00 A.M. under the Chairmanship of Director of Agriculture, Haryana in Committee Room, Krishi Bhawan, Panchkula.

List of Participants is attached at Annexure-I.

The Additional Director Agriculture (General) welcomed the participants and started the discussion on the agenda. The point wise agenda items discussed are as under:

1. Area coverage under different crops & production.

The district-wise area coverage under different Kharif crops was reviewed. All DDA's assured that they have completed the assigned targets of area during current Kharif season. Further, area under sugarcane crops in various districts was reviewed and informed the house that there is lot of variation in the area of sugarcane received from DDAs, Sugar Mills and Remote sensing. Therefore, the Addl.C.C directed to DDAs to constitute a committee and conduct a survey to submit the final report regarding the area covered under sugarcane crop before the next monthly review meeting.

2. Crop Condition.

The crop condition was reviewed. Generally , crop condition in paddy belt found very good but in case of cotton belt, some incidence of White Fly have been observed specially in late sowing crops. After campaigning the incidence of white fly found below ETL in cotton growing districts. It is also suggested by ADA (Gen.) to conduct a survey on the the impact of white fly on different BT Hybrids.

3. Diversification Programme (RKVY)-

During the discussion, DDAs informed that the area under DSR can be increased by providing the DSR machines on subsidy to the farmers. ADA (Gen.) directed DDAs of paddy growing area to send the demands of DSR machines so that required budget may be made available for the DSR machine accordingly.

DDA Karnal make a wish to visit the demonstration plots of DSR in Punjab. ADA (Gen.) suggested if the DDAs of paddy grown area desired to visit Punjab for the study/observation of DSR. Fields proposal in this regard be submitted to Director Agriculture.

4. Agricultural Technology Management Agency. (ATMA):

Administrative –cum- Financial Sanction approval for disbursing of the amount already sent to the Government.

5. Availability of inputs (Seed, Fertilizer and Pesticides).

DDAs informed that the availability and supply of seeds, Fertilizers and Agro-chemicals are satisfactory in their respective districts. Additional Cane Commissioner assured that no shortage of fertilizer in the market till date and plenty of urea have been made available to the farmers in the state during the current Kharif season.

6. Quality Control Enforcement.

All the DDAs have already submitted the reports related to the quality control enforcement and Chairman directed to expedite the checking and sampling of agriculture inputs from all dealers premises in the State.

7. Soil and Water Management –

DDAs ensured for timely collection of Soil Samples and achievement of the targets before the sowing season of Rabi crops.

Special directions issued by Chairman.

- Chairman directed to all the DDAs to send the information regarding Acts and Rules which are no longer needed or relevant in Agriculture Department within a week positively
- All DDAs were also directed to send information regarding restructuring of existing posts in the Department.
- Chairman also directed to all DDAs to send their elaborated views regarding Agricultural Crop Insurance Policy.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.
