



**ORDER**

The appellant has filed the present appeal against the impugned order No. 982 dated 30.03.2015 passed by the Licensing Authority-cum-Deputy Director of Agriculture, Jind whereby his Insecticide License No. 722 was cancelled.

Briefly, the facts of the case are that the appellant is holder of a Insecticide license to sell insecticide/pesticides. The above license was valid upto 31.12.2014. The appellant applied to the respondent for renewal of said license on 08.06.2015 and in response to the same it had been informed by the respondent to the appellant that his licence has already been cancelled vide letter dated 30.03.2015 due to the non renewing the same within stipulated period as envisaged in the Insecticides Act, 1968 and Rules made there-under. Hence, the present appeal.

Sh. Krishan Kumar, Prop. appeared on behalf of the appellant. He has admitted that he could not get his license renewed in time due to illness of his father.

I have heard both the parties and perused the relevant record.

The license of the appellant was valid upto 31.12.2014. Admittedly, the appellant did not apply for renewal of his license within the prescribed period. The explanation given by the appellant is



genuine. Although it has been established that the appellant has contravened the provisions of The Insecticides Act and the Rules made there-under, yet the violation is not so grave which warrants debarring the appellant from doing the business of sale of Insecticides/Pesticides. Hence, the delay is condoned.

In view of the above, I, M. Shayin, IAS, Director of Agriculture, Haryana exercising the powers of Appellate Authority under Section 15 of The Insecticides Act, 1968 accept the present appeal and set aside the impugned order dated 30.03.2015 subject to deposition of penalty of Rs. 12000/- within a period of 15 days of receipt of this order

I order accordingly.
